Chapter makes choristerships available to those children who sing in the Minster choir. These have a minimum value of 60% of a Prep pupil fee, but these can be supplemented up to 100% on a means-tested basis.

Discounts may be given as follows:

Prep	Second or subsequent children 10%
Pre-prep	Second or subsequent children 5% (does not apply to part time Nursery)
With the proviso that one full fee is paid for an elder child	

Children are accepted into Nursery from the term in which they attain their third birthday. To ensure continuity and routine, we suggest children start by attending five sessions (preferably mornings) with the option of three mornings as a minimum for the first half term. There is no facility for afternoon-only sessions.

Reception children may, if necessary, attend for a minimum of five mornings and two afternoons during the first half term. Thereafter, they are expected to attend on five full days and fees are charged on that basis.

All school fees are to be paid in full before the start of term. Interest will be payable on any fees and/or extras not paid by the due date at such rate as shall be fixed, from time to time, by the Governors.

Notice of a pupil's removal from the school must be given in writing before the start of the pupil's last term at the school. A full term's fees in lieu become due if such notice is not given.

The Governors reserve the right to alter the fees at any time throughout the school year.

MUSIC (paid in arrears)

Tuition per musical instrument will be £27.50 per 40 minute lesson, and usually averages 11 lessons per term. Certain musical instruments are available for hire from the school at a charge of £40 per term. If you wish to withdraw your child from music lessons charged as supplemental, you shall either give a term's notice to that effect or shall pay a term's charges to the music teacher through the normal billing process.

Where a music lesson is missed through the child's fault, the lesson will be charged because the teacher's presence and travelling time are involved but, of course, music teachers make no charge when they themselves are absent.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Optional extras are led by specialist staff and teaching staff. Costs vary and are listed on the Activities Sheet that parents receive each term. These are charged in arrears.

PUPILS' PERSONAL ACCIDENT INSURANCE SCHEME

There is a charge of £4.55 per term for this insurance scheme.
